INCLEMENT WEATHER PROCEDURE

(Revised January 2018 – please destroy all other printed instructions)
(please discuss these arrangements with your class/home group and display on your room noticeboard)

INCLEMENT (Cold or Hot)

1. **Three** siren blasts will indicate the start and finish of **Inclement** Weather Procedure. A Leadership team member will determine when the siren is to be sounded.
 - 3 sirens indicate the start of inclement weather procedure - this may occur before the start of a break or during the break.
 - 3 subsequent sirens indicate the finish of inclement weather procedure.

NOTE: If the weather is 35⁰C or above according to BOM, the bell will be rung by office staff.

2. **Primary students (R-6) must go** to their classroom/Primary School area and remain there until the break ends or the siren sounds again to end inclement weather procedures. The Primary Lawns, Courtyard and Oval become out of bounds areas and the yard duty teachers allocated to the Primary Lawns and Courtyard help supervise Primary students in their classrooms.
3. **Year 7 – 11 students have the option** of going to the Resource Centre. The Oval become out of bounds and the yard duty teacher allocated to the Oval supervises students in the Resource Centre.
4. **Year 12 students have the option** of going to the Year 12 Room or the Resource Centre.
5. **Usual arrangements** apply for the Gym, Resource Centre, Canteen/Centre yard duty areas.
