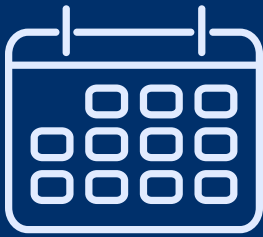




ONLINE LEARNING

Student Agreements



1. FOLLOW YOUR TIMETABLE

Follow your regular class timetable across the week or the daily lesson on seesaw. Lessons will start as shown on the online timetable

2. CHECK SENTRAL/TEAMS/SEESAW

Check sentral or seesaw for lessons notes as normal. Secondary students download all resources required via sentral/teams for your lesson in advance. Teachers will post lessons by 8am each day.



3. BE ON TIME

You must be on time to your virtual lesson, as teachers will be taking attendance just like a normal class.

4. VIDEO CONFERENCING

In the first 10 minutes of each class your teacher will start a teams video conference call to introduce the lesson and check in.



5. COMMUNICATE

Teachers will be available for the duration of each scheduled lesson. You can communicate with your teacher and other students using Posts in teams, if needed.

6. END OF LESSON

Check in with your teacher in the final 10 minutes of each lesson. Make sure you provide evidence of the work you completed during the lesson as set by your teacher.
